



Road Safety GB Membership Terms and Conditions

Specific Terms and Conditions for Members

By becoming a member of Road Safety GB, you agree to comply with the following terms and conditions.

1 Eligibility

1.1 Membership is available to:

1. Individuals.
1. Corporate bodies.
2. Local Authorities.
3. Partnership organisations; and
4. Other organisations

provided they are dedicated to advancing road safety within the United Kingdom.

1.2 Road Safety GB reserves the right to refuse or withdraw membership where the eligibility criteria are not met or cease to be met.

2 Membership fees

2.1 An annual membership fee, as determined by Road Safety GB, is payable by all members.

2.2 The membership fee may vary by membership type and may be changed by Road Safety GB from time to time.

2.3 Membership fees must be paid in full and by the due date specified on the invoice or renewal notice.

2.4 Membership fees are non-refundable once paid, including where membership is terminated early or membership benefits are not used.

3 Code of conduct

3.1 Members shall:

1. Uphold Road Safety GB's values, aims and objectives.
2. Act professionally and respectfully in all dealings associated with Road Safety GB; and
3. Refrain from any conduct that is unlawful, discriminatory, or likely to bring Road Safety GB into disrepute.

3.2 Breaches of this clause may result in suspension or termination of membership in accordance with clause 6.

4 Use of resources

4.1 Members may access Road Safety GB resources, events and training for personal or organisational use only.

4.2 Members shall not distribute, share, reproduce, or make available any Road Safety GB resources to non-members without prior written approval from Road Safety GB.

4.3 Road Safety GB reserves the right to restrict access to resources where misuse is identified.

5 Data protection

5.1 Personal data shall be collected, processed and stored in accordance with applicable data protection legislation.

5.2 Personal data shall be handled in line with Road Safety GB's Privacy Policy, as updated from time to time.

5.3 Members are responsible for ensuring that the personal data they provide is accurate and kept up to date.

6 Termination of membership

6.1 Road Safety GB may suspend or terminate membership where a member:

1. Breaches these terms and conditions.
2. Fails to pay membership fees in accordance with clause 2; or
3. Acts in a manner contrary to the interests of Road Safety GB.

6.2 Suspension or termination shall not give rise to any refund of membership fees.

7 Amendments

7.1 Road Safety GB may amend these terms and conditions from time to time.

7.2 Members shall be notified of any material changes.

7.3 Continued membership following notification of changes shall constitute acceptance of the amended terms.

7.4 Fast Track member details may be amended a maximum of two times per membership year.

8 Governing law

8.1 These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.

9 Addition of further terms

9.1 Road Safety GB may propose additional terms and conditions to reflect evolving needs.

9.2 Any additional terms shall be communicated to all members.

9.3 Additional terms shall take effect once formally adopted by Road Safety GB.

10 Partnership membership

10.1 Partnership membership cannot be included within a Local Authority umbrella membership.

10.2 Partnership membership is a separate category and must be applied for independently.

11 Acceptance of terms

11.1 By applying for or renewing membership, members confirm that they have read, understood and agreed to these terms and conditions.

11.2 Members acknowledge that additional terms may be introduced in accordance with clause 9.
