Remembrance Service for those Killed on the Roads

At 1500hrs on Sunday 15th November 2015 a Service of Remembrance will be held at St Pauls Church, Bedford in memory of all people killed on the roads of Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire and Hertfordshire.

The Service is being hosted by the Road Victims Trust- a local registered charity that provides free emotional and practical support to all persons affected by a road death across the 3 counties. This year marks the 20th anniversary of the Trust. Each year over 80 people will be killed on the roads across Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire and Hertfordshire – leaving in its wake a trail of trauma and devastation. Last year alone the Trust provided its unique services to 249 people whose lives had been affected by the death of a loved one, friend or colleague.

This years' service will be led by Father Kevin Goss of St Pauls Church and will be attended by many of the people who have received the services of the Trust.

Speaking about the Service, the Chief Executive of the Trust, Mark Turner said “ The day will be an opportunity to remember all those killed on the roads, and will also serve as an opportunity to thank so many people, such as the Emergency Services, who give so much to ease the plight of the victims. I would like to extend the invite to anyone who would like to come along and pay their own respects and thoughts. We are all very grateful for the support provided by so many over the course of the past 20 years”.
